

SOUTHEAST PREMIERE OF *PAPER MAN* AND *YOUNG HOLLYWOOD* TO OPEN FLORIDA FILM FESTIVAL

Headline Opening Night Film and Party

Orlando, FL – (Mar. 11, 2010) – ENZIAN announced today that the opening night film for the 19th annual Florida Film Festival will be the Southeast premiere of *Paper Man*, directed by Kieran and Michele Mulroney and starring Jeff Daniels, Emma Stone, Ryan Reynolds, Lisa Kudrow, and Kieran Culkin. The Festival, sponsored by Full Sail University, will take place April 9 through 18, 2010.
