Every dollar donated to Enzian Forever between now and August 17, 2016, or until the \$200,000 dollar goal is reached, will be matched by this foundation.

The current focus of the Enzian Forever campaign is a sense of place. Chairman Sigrid Tiedtke said, "Enzian sits on three acres of flowering plants, towering oaks, and untouched natural woodlands. As we expand to three screens, with a new lobby and kitchen, we consider these features sacred and aim to build around our natural Florida environment. This is important to us and our mission because an inviting environment fosters conversation, openness, and discovery. It invites you to look at new perspectives and experience the art of film in a unique way. We couldn't do this without the support of such wonderful foundations as The Edward E. Haddock, Jr. Family Foundation. We are tremendously grateful for their support."

The Enzian Forever campaign has raised over 75% of the \$6 million goal. Enzian intends to reach \$5 million before year's end to break ground by early 2017. Enzian is currently going through the approval process with the City of Maitland. Executive Vice President Elizabeth Mukherjee said, "We hope to complete the City process by early Fall and break ground by the end of this year or beginning of next year. We'll know more by the end of the summer. We aim to complete construction within a year. That could put us at completion in early 2018, in time for the 2018 Florida Film Festival!"
