**ENZIAN'S 25<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL BROUHAHA FILM & VIDEO SHOWCASE IS NOW ACCEPTING SUBMISSIONS**

**Orlando, FL** – (August 19, 2016) – Entering its 25<sup>th</sup> bold year, the Brouhaha Film & Video Showcase is an annual event celebrating Florida's finest up and coming independent film and video makers.

Once again, Brouhaha serves as a vetting process for the Florida Film Festival with a jury of local experts selecting films to be screened at the prestigious 26<sup>th</sup> Annual FFF (April 21 – April 30, 2017) in the "Best of Brouhaha" program. There will also be an Audience Award granting one film guaranteed inclusion in the 2017 Florida Film Festival. Brouhaha will take place over two afternoons on Saturday, November 19<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, November 20<sup>th</sup>. The screenings will be held at Enzian Theater in Maitland, Florida.

This year, Brouhaha is allowing each school to submit up to 15 minutes of work free of charge that Brouhaha will showcase (time and schedule permitting). Submissions must be narrative, documentary or animated shorts (no PSAs or commercials please).

Entries may be submitted for preview via a secure online screener (VIMEO preferred) or via DVD. Accepted exhibition formats are .mov or .avi media files (preferred format) or Blu-Ray.

The submission deadline is October 14, 2016, at which time, a 25-word well-written, concise synopsis of the basic plot and premise of the work(s) will be required along with a high-resolution Black & White or Color Still.

Additional entries above and beyond the first 15 minutes may be submitted but must include a \$10.00 entry fee per film.
