NEW SEASON OF NATIONAL THEATRE LIVE PRODUCTIONS**

Orlando, FL – (January 16, 2019) – Enzian and Annie Russell Theatre are proud to present another season of National Theatre Live, the National Theatre's groundbreaking project to broadcast the best of British theatre from the London stage to cinemas around the world. Enzian is currently scheduled to play three productions: *Antony & Cleopatra*, starring Ralph Fiennes; Alan Bennett's *Allelujah!*; and *Macbeth*, starring Rory Kinnear.

Recorded from the National Theatre, Ralph Fiennes and Sophie Okonedo play Shakespeare's famous fated couple in his great tragedy of politics, passion and power.

Caesar and his assassins are dead. General Mark Antony now rules alongside his fellow defenders of Rome. But at the fringes of a war-torn empire the Egyptian Queen Cleopatra and Mark Antony have fallen fiercely in love. In a tragic fight between devotion and duty, obsession becomes a catalyst for war.

Director Simon Godwin returns to National Theatre Live screens with this hotly anticipated production, following previous broadcasts of *Twelfth Night*, *Man and Superman* and *The Beaux' Stratagem*.

Filmed live at London's Bridge Theatre during its limited run, don't miss Alan Bennett's 'rousing chorus line for the NHS' (*Observer*).

The Beth, an old fashioned cradle-to-grave hospital serving a town on the edge of the Pennines, is threatened with closure as part of an efficiency drive. A documentary crew,

eager to capture its fight for survival, follows the daily struggle to find beds on the Dusty Springfield Geriatric Ward, and the triumphs of the old people's choir.

Alan Bennett's celebrated plays include *The History Boys*, *The Lady in the Van* and *The Madness of George III*, all of which were also seen on film. *Allelujah!* is his tenth collaboration with award-winning director Nicholas Hytner.

The ruined aftermath of a bloody civil war. Ruthlessly fighting to survive, the Macbeths are propelled towards the crown by forces of elemental darkness.

Shakespeare's most intense and terrifying tragedy, directed by Rufus Norris (*The Threepenny Opera*, *London Road*), sees Rory Kinnear (*Othello*) and Anne-Marie Duff (*Suffragette*) play Macbeth and Lady Macbeth.
