ENZIAN PRESENTS NEW SEASON OF NATIONAL THEATRE LIVE PRODUCTIONS

Orlando, FL – (August 28, 2020) – Enzian is proud to present another season of National Theatre Live, in partnership with Annie Russell Theatre. National Theatre Live is the National Theatre's groundbreaking project to broadcast the best of British theatre from the London stage to cinemas around the world. Enzian is currently scheduled to play three productions: *Cyrano de Begerac*, starring James McAvoy; *Frankenstein*, starring Benedict Cumberbatch and Jonny Lee Miller; and *Fleabag*, starring Phoebe Waller-Bridge.

Individual tickets to each screening are available for purchase, as well as a <u>Season Pass</u>, which allows patrons to see all three productions at a discount and includes one free glass of house wine at each show.

WHAT: National Theatre Live: Cyrano de Bergerac

A magnetic soldier full of swagger and brilliant poet, Cyrano de Bergerac is in love with his beautiful and intelligent cousin Roxane without her knowing. His one curse in his life, he feels, is his large nose and although it may have been a forming influence in his razer-sharp wit, he believes that Roxane will reject him. When the handsome but unpoetic Christian falls for the beautiful Roxane, he asks Cyrano to help him win her heart. *Cyrano de Bergerac* can be delivered as an allegory of inner and outer beauty. 2020, 170 minutes

Captured live in 2011 from the National Theatre stage in London, this thrilling, sold-out production became an international sensation, experienced by almost half a million people in cinemas around the world.

Directed by Academy Award®-winner Danny Boyle (*Trainspotting, Slumdog Millionaire*), *Frankenstein* features Benedict Cumberbatch (*Hamlet*, BBC's *Sherlock*) as The Creature and Jonny Lee Miller (*Elementary, Trainspotting*) as Victor Frankenstein.

Childlike in his innocence but grotesque in form, Frankenstein's bewildered creature is cast out into a hostile universe by his horror-struck maker. Meeting with cruelty

wherever he goes, the increasingly desperate and vengeful Creature determines to track down his creator and strike a terrifying deal.
